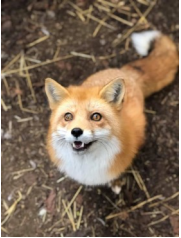


Current Support Opportunities

Exterior Education Habitat Sponsorships:

Each habitat sponsorship will come with a name placard on the habitat fencing for a minimum of 5 years, recognition with links on our website, and inclusion in all grand opening celebration materials.

Ambassadors being housed in each habitat may rotate seasonally or as a result of lifespan. The sponsorship remains with the habitat structure regardless of animals being housed there.



Large Mammal Habitat Anticipated Habitat Size: 2,048 square feet.

The large mammal habitat will currently be home to Lenny the Red Fox. Lenny was found running around at a local park emaciated and approaching people in 2013. We believe he was not ever a wild fox because of his behavior and markings and either escaped or was released. Lenny did not know how to survive in the wild and joined us as an education ambassador.

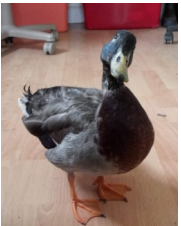

Large Raptor Habitat: Anticipated Habitat Size: 8 Individual 200 square foot habitats, 1,600 total square feet

The large raptor habitat will house our Barred Owl, Barn Owl, Great Horned Owl, Red Shouldered Hawk, Red Tailed Hawk, Black Vulture and Harris Hawk. Each of these education ambassadors will have individual habitats with viewing as part of the entire structure. Individual habitat sponsorships will also be sold, but signage for over-all structure will indicate sponsor support level.

Waterfowl Habitat: Anticipated Habitat Size: 320 total square feet

The waterfowl habitat will house our current education ambassador Martin the duck as well as other select non-releasable waterfowl that we will apply to keep in coming years. The habitat will feature both land and aquatic areas for the animals to enjoy.

Small Raptor Habitat: Anticipated Habitat Size: 3 Individual 100 square foot habitats, 300 total square feet

The small raptor habitat will house our screech owl, American crow, and American kestrel. Each of these education ambassadors will have individual habitats with viewing as part of the entire structure. Individual habitat sponsorships will also be sold, but signage for overall structure will indicate sponsor support level.

Small Mammal Habitat: Anticipated Habitat Size: 2 Individual 200 square foot habitats, 400 total square feet

The small mammal habitat will be home to our current woodchuck and opossum ambassadors and rotate seasonally with other small mammals. The habitat will feature nesting areas and enrichment areas for the animals.
